Our Team

Nightingale Care Home is supported by a qualified and experienced care team, led by our Home Manager. The team includes skilled nurses and caregivers who are on duty 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

We continually invest in training our team to help them develop and gain NVQ qualifications in care. This helps us to continue to improve the care provided to all residents.

We are very proud of the long length of service of many of our team, which helps us to provide a stable and caring environment for our residents. We also have specialist team members to provide an extensive and innovative activities programme to encourage residents to enjoy their stay to the full.
